



Membership Standards of Behavior and Responsibilities

Peace in Medicine's members must abide by the following, and will be required to attest to this during the membership process. Peace in Medicine reserves the right to terminate membership for any violations of the standards of behavior and responsibilities with no warnings or second chances.

1. Members are required to carry valid, government issued, **identification** and proof of their status as a valid California **medical patient** or **qualified caregiver** whenever they are visiting the dispensary or events.
2. All medicine obtained through the dispensary is for the personal medical use of the patient member and may **not be resold or distributed** to any non member under any circumstances.
3. Purchases will not exceed the **limits** designated as **personal consumption** for the qualified patient regardless of the number of caregivers.
4. Members are to be **respectful of the neighborhood** where dispensary is located. No loitering, loud music, littering, posting, flying or soliciting is allowed within the Gravenstien Station premises.
5. Members and staff are to treat each other with **respect** and **courtesy** at all times. Offensive, abusive and/or threatening language and/or behavior is prohibited.
6. Members are not to bring electronic audio, video, or photographic recording, broadcasting, or transmitting devices inside the dispensary without prior written consent from an authorized agent. This includes **cameras, telephones, personal music players** and all **headsets**.
7. Members are not to bring and/or use **alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons** inside or around the premises of the dispensary.
8. Members are not to misrepresent Peace in Medicine by **posting stickers, posters, or any other dispensary materials** in any public spaces.
9. You must be at least **eighteen (18)** years old and have California DMV issued identification to access dispensary services.
10. Only qualified patients or their caregivers are **allowed** within the dispensary area of Peace in Medicine.
11. We invite all guests to wait in our lobby as each member is responsible for guest behavior inside and outside the building.
12. **No consumption** of cannabis is allowed within the Gravenstein Station property and healing center premises.
13. There is **no loitering** in the Gravenstein Station.
14. Members are limited to **one dispensary visit** per day.
15. Only **qualified service animals** are allowed inside the premises, all other pets are not allowed.
16. For your safety, place all medication and plants **out of sight** before leaving the building.
17. Please be friendly and support our neighbors with your patronage.
18. In case of an emergency (law enforcement action, fire, power outage, etc.) stay calm and follow the instructions from the Peace in Medicine staff.
